Families of Freedom Scholarship Fund Estimated Award Amount Worksheet

Scholarship America determines the final award amount by looking at a number of factors. School costs, the amount the family is expected to contribute (Suggested Parent Contribution or SPC), and other scholarships and grants received by the student are considered when determining financial need and the final award amount. Scholarship America does not pay 100% of financial need because we need to ensure that funds are available until the year 2030 for all eligible dependents. The percentage of need fluctuates from year to year and is largely dependent on the number of registrants projected to use the fund over its lifetime. The percentage of need to be paid for the 2024-25 academic year is 80%.

Terms for completing the estimated award amount worksheet:

School costs

School costs include: tuition and fees, room and board, and books. Use the **annual** cost of attendance provided to you by the school.

Scholarship America annually receives the cost of attendance for full-time students from The College Board; therefore, our calculation is based on the cost of attendance reported by the school to The College Board. The amount used in your calculation above may vary from the amount used in the final calculation used by Scholarship America.

Suggested Parent Contribution (SPC)

Use the value provided to you from the SPC calculator.

Other Scholarships/Grants

A student may receive other scholarships and grants from various sources. The total amount of this aid is deducted from the financial need formula to avoid duplication of payment for allowed expenses. Use the **annual** expected aid total.

If a student is eligible to receive funds from the New York State World Trade Center Memorial Scholarship, you must include that amount in the total.

Estimated Annual Award Amount

Determine the **award amount** by applying the percentage of need that the Fund can pay to the calculated Financial Need amount. This percentage may change from year to year, based on our annual actuarial studies. The percent of need to be paid for the 2024-25 academic year is 80% of financial need.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

This award estimate may be different than your actual award as calculated by the Families of Freedom Scholarship Fund. Changes to family income, number of family members attending college, school costs, additional aid received, the financial need calculation, or the annual percentage of need, will result in changes to the estimated scholarship award amount.
